### **KNB ADOPT-A-MILE SAFETY RULES**



- 1. Park vehicles clear of roadway. Get approval from owner before parking on private property.
- 2. Keep work groups to a manageable size.
- 3. Closely supervise youth groups. (Children must be 12 or older to participate.)
- 4. Be aware of traffic, and stay well away from the edges of busy roads.
- 5. If working near water, account for anyone who cannot swim.
- 6. Do not remove any hazardous material. Do not touch broken glass, needles, or dead animals.
- Wear brightly colored clothing and closed-toe shoes.
- 8. Use sunscreen and bug spray as needed.
- 9. Do not pick up items on bridges, tunnels, or overpasses.
- 10. Stay clear of construction areas.
- 11. Do not pick up litter during inclement weather, hours of darkness, or peak traffic hours.
- 12. Be aware of possible contact with poisonous plants, stinging insects, fire ants, and snakes.
- 13. Consider the possibility of any participant's known allergies prior to litter pick-up, and be sure you have Epi-pens and/or Benadryl on hand for anyone with allergies.
- 14. Do not allow participants to partake of, possess, or distribute alcoholic beverages while involved in cleanup.
- 15. Make participants aware that they are working in a potentially dangerous environment and caution them to act accordingly.
