

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF NEWTON COUNTY, GEORGIA ADOPTING THE MILLAGE RATE FOR 2019 PROPERTY TAXES

WHEREAS, Article 1, Title 36, Section 81, Paragraph I of the Official Code of Georgia, requires, among other things, that counties prepare and adopt a balanced budget annually; and

WHEREAS, on June 18, 2019, the Newton County Board of Commissioners adopted its Fiscal Year 2020 Operating Budget for the General Fund, which lists proposed expenditures, proposes certain levies and charges to finance such expenditures, and lists the anticipated revenues to be derived therefrom for the period beginning July 1, 2019, and ending June 30, 2020; and

WHEREAS, the proposed Fiscal Year 2020 Operating Budget is balanced, such that projected revenues for each fund equal proposed expenditure appropriations; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to notices published in accordance with O.C.G.A. § 48-5-32.1, public hearings were conducted on July 29, 2019 at 11:00 a.m. and 6:00 p.m., and on August 6, 2019 at 6:00 p.m. with respect to the adoption of the proposed millage rate of 13.43; and

WHEREAS, at its regular called meeting held on August 6, 2019 at 7:00 p.m. and after public notice of the same, the Newton County Board of Commissioners met for the purpose of adopting and levying a millage rate of 13.43.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT AND IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED, that a millage rate of 13.43 is hereby adopted and levied for tax year 2019.
