

**A RESOLUTION OF THE NEWTON COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS  
AUTHORIZING A CHANGE TO THE HOURS OF OPERATION  
FOR THE COUNTY'S COLLECTION CENTERS**

**WHEREAS**, the Constitution of the State of Georgia, approved by the voters of the State in November of 1982, and effective July 1, 1983, provides in Article IX, Section II, Paragraph I thereof, that the governing authority of the County may adopt clearly reasonable ordinances, resolutions and regulations; and

**WHEREAS**, the Constitution of the State of Georgia, approved by the voters of the State in November of 1982, and effective July 1, 1983, provides in Article IX, Section II, Paragraph III thereof, that the governing authority of the County is empowered to provide for garbage and solid waste collection and disposal services; and

**WHEREAS**, the County previously entered into a certain Contract for Services with Junior Hilliard General Services, dated February 5, 2013, for the operation and maintenance of the County's Recycling and Waste Collection Centers (the "Contract for Services"); and

**WHEREAS**, Exhibit A to the "Contract for Services" specifically provides that "Newton County reserves the right to increase/decrease the hours of operation for each Collection Center [as such Collection Centers are listed in Exhibit A, attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference] as deemed necessary without an increase to the hourly rate charge;" and

**WHEREAS**, the County has found it necessary and desires to exercise its right to decrease the hours of operation for the Collection Centers and wishes to notify the community and Junior Hilliard General Services of such change.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF NEWTON COUNTY, GEORGIA AS FOLLOWS:**

**Section 1. Adoption of Change in Hours of Operation for Collection Centers.**

The Newton County Board of Commissioners, acting on behalf of Newton County, Georgia, deems it necessary to decrease and does hereby decrease the hours of operation for the Collection Centers (as listed in Exhibit A) to the hours reflected in Exhibit A to this Resolution, attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference.

This change to the hours of operation for the Collection Centers shall become effective thirty (30) calendar days after written notice of such change is published in the County's legal organ, posted at the relevant Collection Centers, and provided to Junior Hilliard General Services.

**Section 2. Written Notice.**

The Newton County Board of Commissioners hereby directs the County Manager to

provide written notice of this change in hours of operation for the Collection Centers to the public by publishing notice of such change in the County's legal organ and by posting notice of such change at the Collection Centers.

Further, in accordance with Exhibit A of the Contract for Services, the Newton County Board of Commissioners hereby directs the County Manager to provide written notice of this change in hours of operation for the Collection Centers, as specified in Section A of Exhibit A of the Contract for Services, to the hours reflected in Exhibit A to this Resolution, attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference. Such change shall not affect the hourly rate charge provided in the Contract for Services, which is set at \$11.29 per hour. Written notice shall be provided to Junior Hilliard General Services pursuant to the notice provision outlined in Section 12(b) of the Contract for Services.

**Section 3. Repealer.**

Any County resolutions or policies in conflict with this Resolution or the attached Exhibit A are hereby repealed and are ineffective and unenforceable to the extent that they conflict with the terms of this Resolution.

**Section 4. Effective Date.**

The effective date of this Resolution shall be the date of adoption.



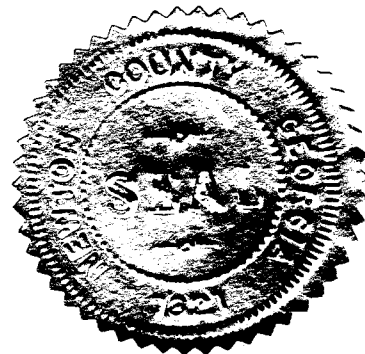
