- () Section IV.B.11. Building in which establishment will be located must meet applicable lighting standards (lighting plan to be reviewed and approved by Newton County Landscape Architect).
- () Section IV.B.12. Must submit evidence of ownership of building or a copy of lease. If applicant is a franchisee, must submit copy or franchise agreement.
- () Section IV.B.13. Building in which establishment will be located must have adequate sanitary toilet facilities and parking spaces and the interior shall be illuminated so that all hallways, passageways and open areas may be clearly seen by customers therein (to be reviewed and approved by Newton County Building Inspector and Zoning Administrator).
- () Section IV.C.1. Must meet all distance requirements (survey to be reviewed and approved by Newton County Zoning Administrator). Distances shall be measured by the most direct route of travel on the ground from the main customer entrance of the premises to be licensed to the main entrance or the establishments described.
- () Section IX.C. If applicable, outside sales area must be approved (public ingress/egress and height of structure to be reviewed and approved by Newton County Zoning Administrator, Building Inspector and Fire Marshall).
